

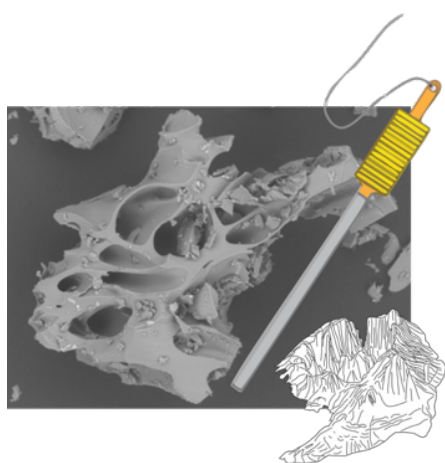
**2<sup>nd</sup> circular**

The Mediterranean region is known to be vulnerable for **submarine and emergent explosive volcanism** that present an ongoing **hazard** for populated regions in many parts of the world.

**This workshop aims to bring together research on modern and ancient marine volcanic deposits, petrology as well as age and climate proxies in a holistic approach using marine exploration, field studies, and experimental and theoretical work from the Mediterranean.**

The workshop invites contributions from marine studies of the Hellenic arc, especially linked to IODP Expedition 398, the Italian volcanic provinces, especially Mt. Etna and Stromboli, Aeolian Island, as well as other Mediterranean marine research linked to volcanology and contributions on related volcanic hazards and risk mitigation.
